Description of the Qualification

The Master of Education (Science Education) is awarded on successful completion of six modules and a dissertation. Each module involves a combination of lectures, tutorials, group work, and requires 200 hours of student learning time.

Credit Transfer

The qualification shown includes any transferred credit for study with another institution. This study is considered by the University to be appropriate for inclusion within the qualification. Full details of the transferred credit are given on the Credit Transfer Award Notification sent to students at the time that the award was made

Credit Points and Levels

The University uses a credit point system in which 180 points is equivalent to a full-time academic year (1800 hours of study). Graduate credit is designated level M.

Total Number of Points

The total figure shows all the credit points that have been counted towards this qualification, including any credit transfer, subordinate award and collaborative courses. Each credit point equates to 10 hours of study.

Method of Teaching and Assessment
The courses recorded on this transcript are taught by an integrated process including examinations and a dissertation. lectures, seminars, tutorials, regular assignments,

Student performance is measured in a series of continuous assessments and assignments that are blind double marked to standards set down by the Board of Examiners for the module and in examinations which are usually two-hour, unseen, written examinations but which might consist of a project or case study. The final programme result depends on the performance in each component of the assessment plan. The Board of Examiners for each programme includes at least one external examiner whose role includes helping to ensure comparability of academic standards with other degree-awarding bodies in the UK.
