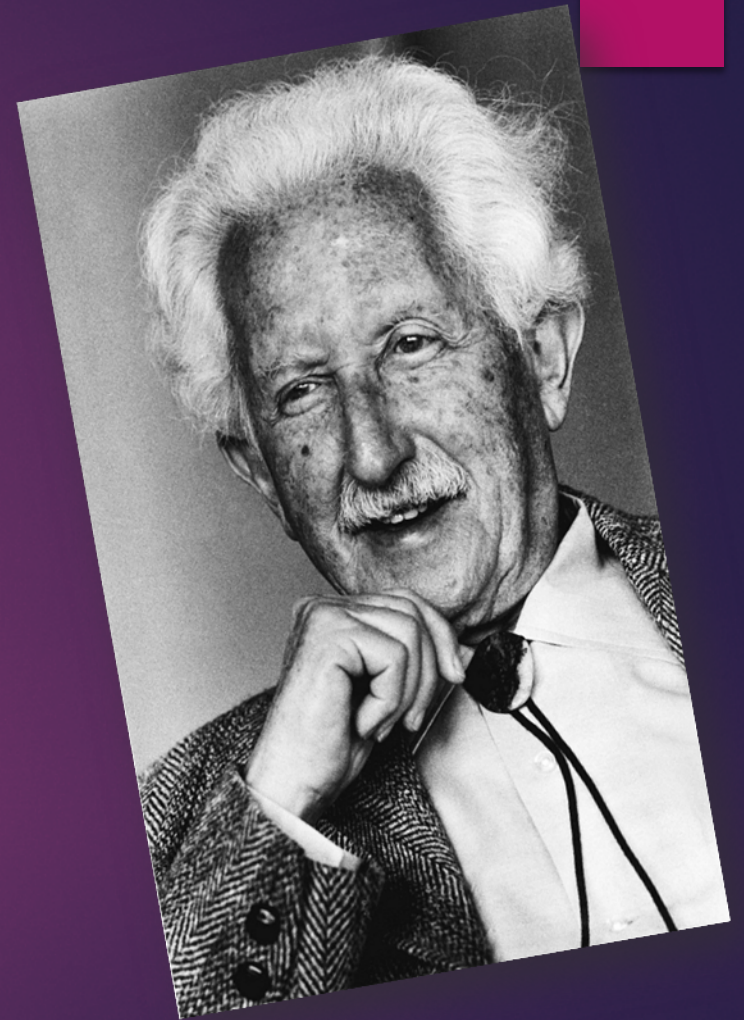


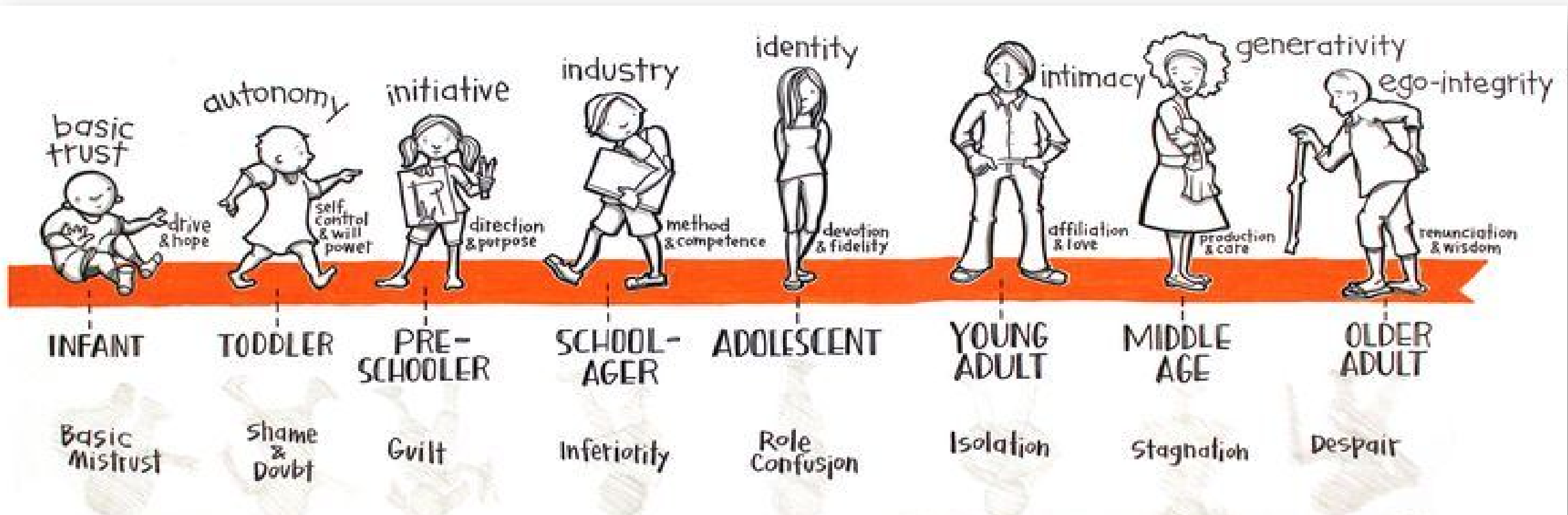

Erikson 8 stages of Development



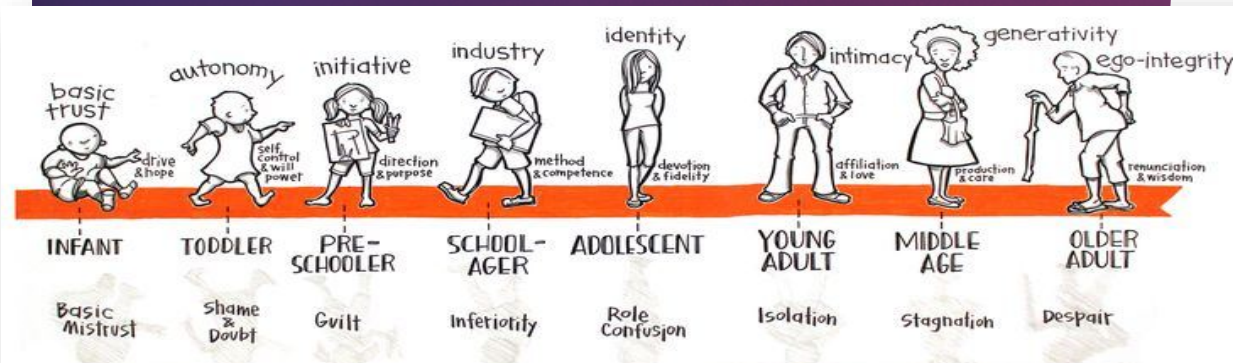
Analyze the stage

If he was exposed to constant ignorance or abuse by people around

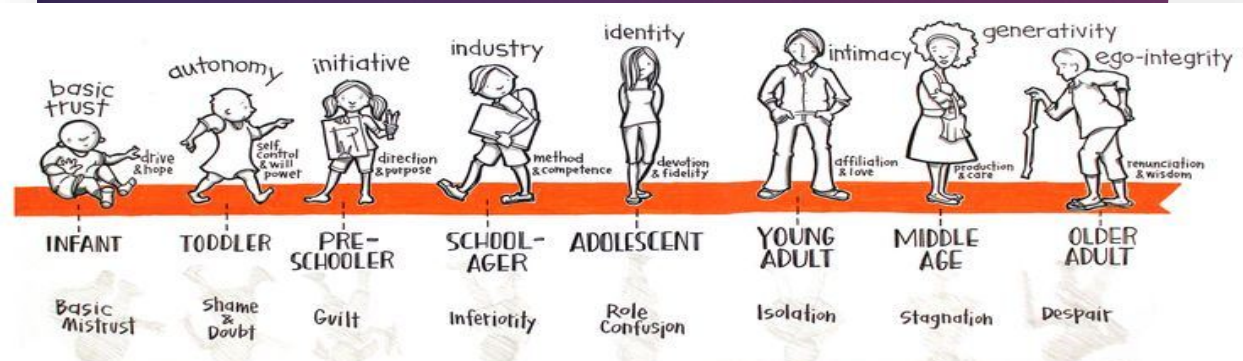


Analyze the stage

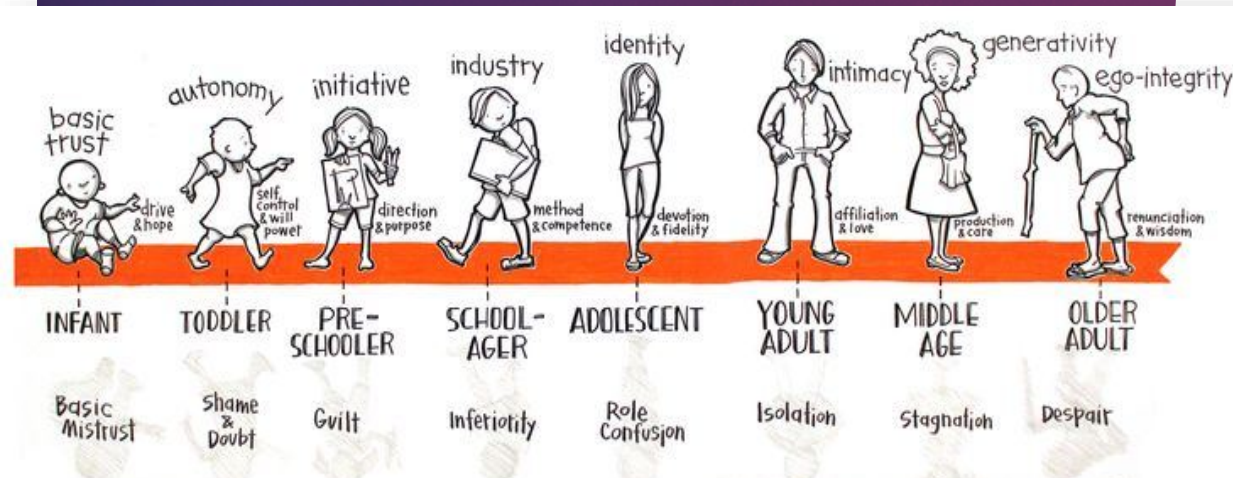


Analyze the stage

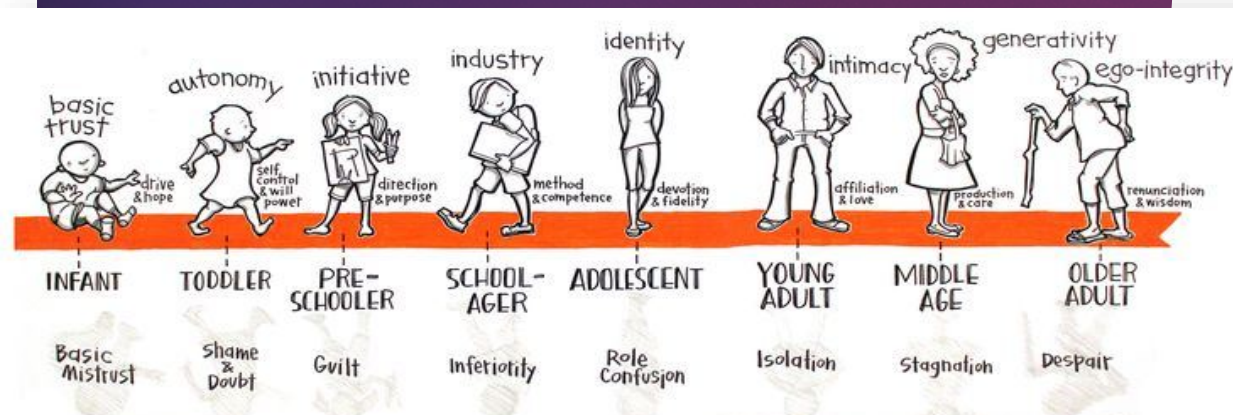


Analyze the stage

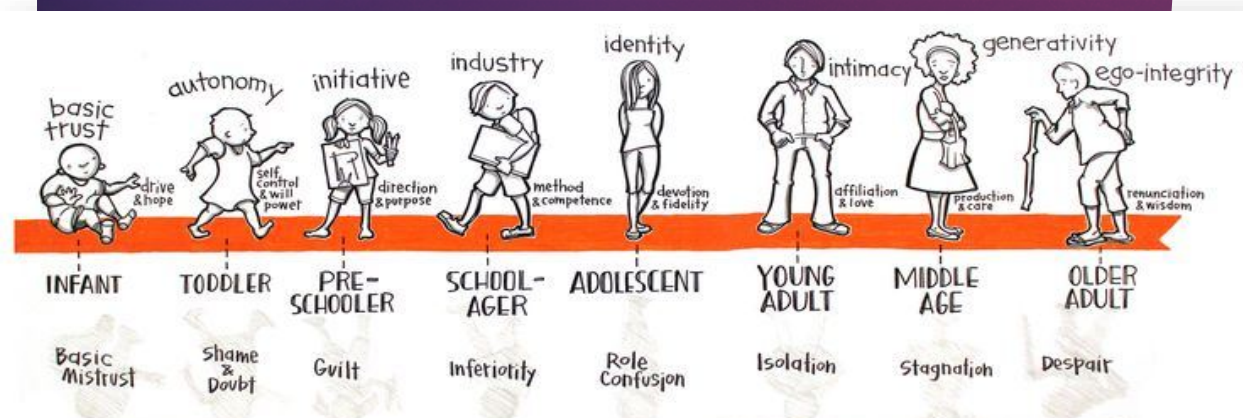


Analyze the stage

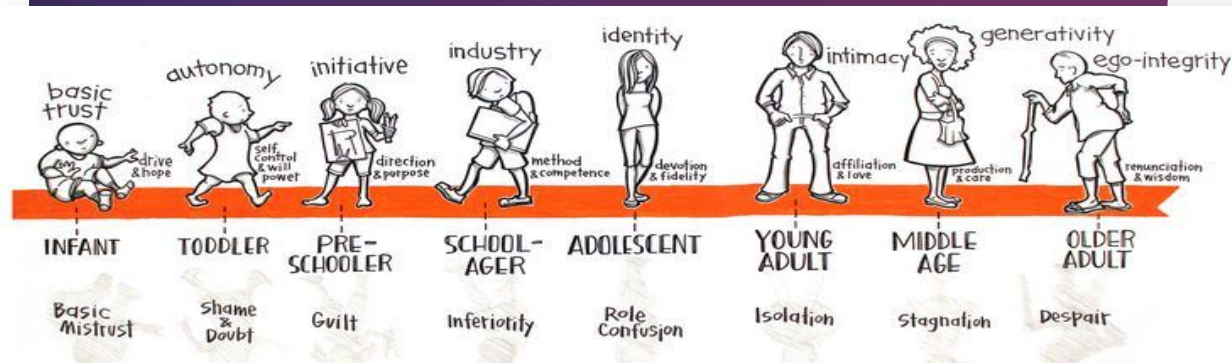


Analyze the stage

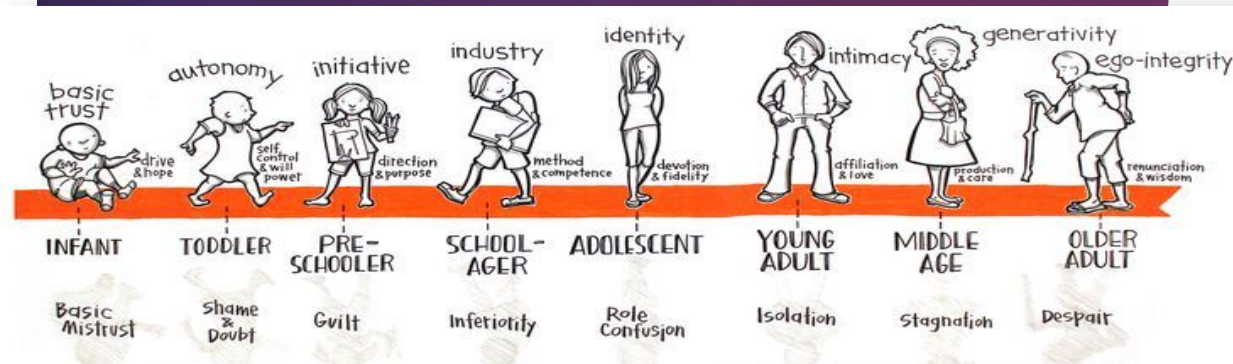


Analyze the stage
